Bill is a Licensed Clinical Social Worker, with 12 years’ experience counseling children, adults, couples and families in psychiatric hospitals and outpatient clinics. For the past 26 years, he has also been a lawyer, representing clients in family court (as a Certified Family Law Specialist) and providing divorce mediation services.

He is the author of over a dozen books, including: *High Conflict People in Legal Disputes*, 2nd Ed.; *SPLITTING: Protecting Yourself While Divorcing Someone with Borderline or Narcissistic Personality Disorder*; and *BIFF: Quick Responses to High Conflict People*. Bill is the developer of the *New Ways for Families*® method for potentially high-conflict families, which is being implemented in several family court systems in the United States and Canada. He is also the developer of the *New Ways for Mediation*® method, which emphasizes more structure by the mediator and more negotiation skills for the parties. ♦
